



## Steve M. Dykstra

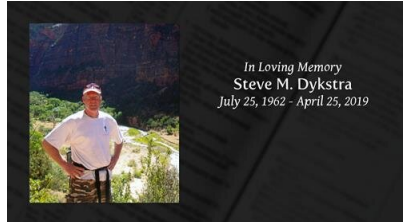
July 25, 1962 - April 25, 2019
