Susan Joy Cook, 68, of Zeeland, went home to the Lord on Monday, December 1, 2025, following a six-year battle with mesothelioma.

Later in '75 she met the love of her life John Cook in Saugatuck, and they married in October of 1976. Susan had bright eyes and an even brighter smile, lighting up every room she entered.

Susan enjoyed her church family and visited her fellow members and friends even when she herself was dealing with illness. Susan also loved horses and kept her own for many years. 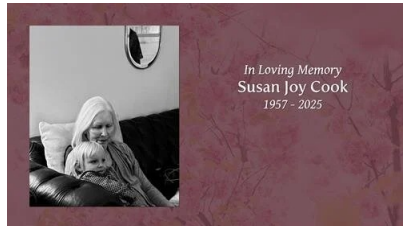
