



Susanne Jessie

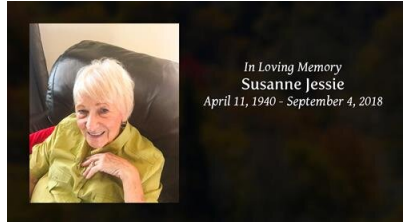
April 11, 1940 - September 4, 2018
