Terry Schurman, age 81, of Holland, passed away Tuesday, October 31, 2023 at his home surrounded by family.

Terry graduated from Holland High School in 1960 and served in the US Army National Guard from 1964-1969. On February 5, 1965 he married the love of his life, Karen Rotman. 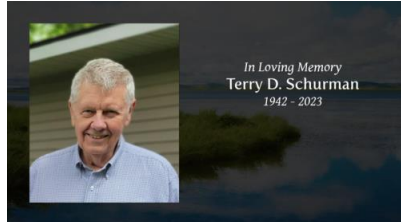
