July 3, 1940 - December 16, 2018

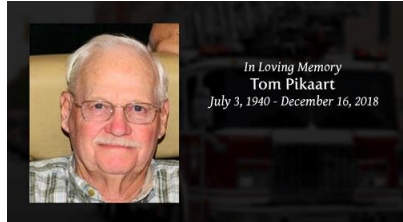
