



Warren Wolters

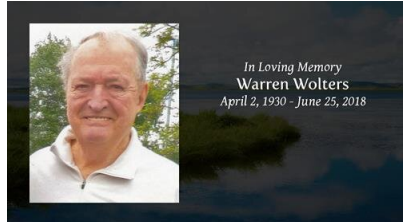
June 25, 1930 - June 25, 2018
