Wayne Glass, age 88, went to be with his Lord and Savior in the early morning hours on Monday, October 7, 2024.

Born August 29, 1936, the 13th out of 15 children. Upon being discharged from the Navy, Wayne began work as a machinist at Bohn Aluminum where he retired from in 2004. Wayne's passions in life centered around his faith, family and music. Taking family vacations and camping trips to the upper UP, Cheboygan, Ludington, Rice Lake in Canada, and many more.
