



William "Bill" Vande Berg

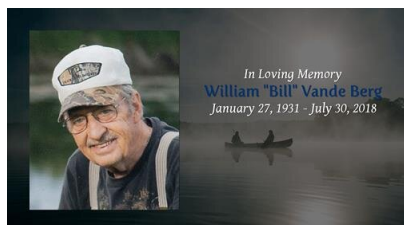
January 27, 1931 - July 30, 2018
